Farmers & Ranchers is a cross Atlantic meeting with twenty youngsters (15-19) that say they want to step in the footstep of their agricultural parents and/or grandparents. Feenstra works from 2012-15 with kids from Friesland (NL) and Colorado (USA). They take us to Friesland and Colorado, and grow up in two stereotyped images of farming life: the dairy cow in the field and the cowboy on the prairie. www.farmersandranchers.nl
With "Farmers & Ranchers" visits and knowledge exchange leads to a documentary film. This long term project includes screenings and shows in e.g. the Fries Museum NL 2014-15, GfZK Leipzig DE 2016, Arts Maebashi JP 2016, OK_Video in Jakarta and ET4U in Jutland DK 2017.

WAPKE FEENSTRA

Made in Zvizzchi. What is produced in the Russian village Zvizzchi after they lost their agriculture production and the daily income during perestroika? To point out the home-made produce and local skills Feenstra decided to set up the open source brand "Made in Zvizzchi" and in 2013 started a small shop vitrine in the existing village shop. Later the visiting geologist found out that there is clay in Zvizzchi, good-quality clay suitable for moulding and firing. So it was chosen as the raw material for ceramics Made in Zvizzchi. In 2015 we built a simple wood-firing oven with the help of some villagers. Two ceramicists were invited to work with this clay and to teach basic technics. The results were first shown in the village during the Archstoyanie Festival, and later in the Moscow Biennale and in Leipzig (GfZK). In 2017 Made in Zvizzchi is part of XII Krasnoyarsk Museum Biennale. http://www.wapke.nl/collections/detail.php?id=37

Wild Treasure is a new created village-object from Beetsterzwaag; developed, designed and made with a skilled and enthusiastic group of villagers.


The anarchistic and socialistic protest movements fed by peat-distraction are still a hot-topic in the area. The shape of the Wild Treasure was inspired by a typical local product: wâldbeantsje. Once the fare of poor people, but have recently found their way onto the menus of modern classy restaurants in the region. To shape the new product, two other particularly local skills entered the process: silver jewellery making and mole hunting. Douwe van de Velde, silversmith and owner of the town's goldsmiths, developed a silver locket that could contain the bean; whilst a local mole-catcher, used the traditional mole hunting technique to catch the animal for its fur.
